

Your 2022-2023 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law says that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we must ask you to confirm the information you and your parents reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, the financial aid administrator at Drew University will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information will be corrected. You and at least one parent must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the Office of Financial Assistance at Drew. Drew University may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact the Office of Financial Assistance as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.
