Cara Blue Adams is the author of the interlinked story collection *You Never Get It Back* (University of Iowa Press, 2021), which was named a New York Times Editors' Choice and awarded the John Simmons Short Fiction Prize, judged by Brandon Taylor, who calls it "a modern classic." It was shortlisted for the Mary McCarthy Prize and longlisted for the Story Prize. She is the recipient of Kenyon Review Short Fiction Prize, the Missouri Review Peden Prize, and the Meringoff Prize in Fiction, along with a 2018 Center for Fiction Emerging Writer fellowship. She has received fellowships and other support from the Bread Loaf Writers' Conference, the Sewanee Writers' Conference, and the New York State Council on the Arts. Her stories appear in *Granta*, *The Kenyon Review*, *American Short Fiction*, *Electric Literature*, and elsewhere. She is an associate professor at Seton Hall University and lives in Brooklyn.
