Born in St. Thomas, U.S.V.I. and raised in Florida, Nicole Sealey is the author of *Ordinary Beast* and *The Animal After Whom Other Animals Are Named*, winner of the 2015 Drinking Gourd Chapbook Poetry Prize. Other honors include the Stanley Kunitz Memorial Prize from The American Poetry Review, a Daniel Varoujan Award, and the Poetry International Prize, as well as fellowships from CantoMundo, MacDowell Colony and the Poetry Project. Her work has appeared in The New Yorker, The New York Times, and elsewhere. She is the executive director at Cave Canem Foundation.

John Murillo is the author of *Up Jump the Boogie*, a finalist for the Kate Tufts Discovery Award and the Pen Open Book Award. His honors include the J. Howard and Barbara M.J. Wood Prize from the Poetry Foundation, a Pushcart Prize, and fellowships from the National Endowment for the Arts, the Bread Loaf Writers Conference, Fine Arts Work Center, and the Wisconsin Institute for Creative Writing. His poems have appeared in Best American Poetry 2017, Poetry, and Ploughshares, and his collection *Kontemporary Amerikan Poetry* is forthcoming from Four Way Books. He teaches at Hampshire College and New York University.
