FAMILY EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT (FERPA) RELEASE

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) is a federal law that prohibits Drew University from releasing a student's education records to third-parties without the student's prior written consent except under certain circumstances identified in the University's policies.
