Hana Berger Moran: The Story of My Mother, Holocaust Survivor

Talk by Thomas Berger

The story of Hana and her mother Priska is featured in the book by Wendy Holden, *Born Survivors: Three Young Mothers and Their Extraordinary Story of Courage, Defiance and Hope*. Priska gave birth to Hana on April 12, 1945, on a wooden plank in a concentration camp in Freiberg, Germany. After a 17-day death train "march," they arrived at the concentration camp in Mauthausen, Austria where they were liberated by the U.S. Third Army's 11th Armored Division a few days later.
