Certification of United Methodist MDiv Residency Drew Theological School

According to the Book of Discipline, United Methodist MDiv students must complete at least one third of their studies in person. An in person class means that at least 50% of the learning happens in person with the instructor and fellow students (including intensive courses). For Drew, students need 26 credits of in person learning (which is 2/3rds of 78 credits).

The chart below can be used to track a student's courses that meet this residency requirement. Once the student has 26 credits, they can submit the form to Dr. Newburg, Director of Methodist Studies (knewburg@drew.edu), who will sign and return the form to the student. This optional certification is provided to students for their documentation for their Board of Ordained Ministry.
